- 1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA,
- 2 SECOND SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2024, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- To amend Article VII, section 3:
- 7 VII-3 (1) Until the terms commencing in 2027, the The State Board of
- 8 Education shall be composed of eight members, who shall be elected from
- 9 eight districts of substantially equal population as provided by the
- 10 Legislature. Beginning with the terms commencing in 2027, the State Board
- 11 of Education shall have seven members. The Governor shall appoint two
- 12 members subject to the approval of the Legislature. At the statewide
- 13 general election in 2026, one member shall be elected from each
- 14 congressional district and two members shall be elected at large.
- 15 (2) The <del>Their</del> term of office shall be for four years each. Their
- 16 duties and powers shall be prescribed by the Legislature, and they shall
- 17 receive no compensation, but shall be reimbursed their actual expense
- 18 incurred in the performance of their duties. The members of the State
- 19 Board of Education shall not be actively engaged in the educational
- 20 profession, and they shall be elected on a nonpartisan ballot.
- 21 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 22 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 23 section 1, with the following ballot language:
