Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB357

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB357 would increase fees for the titling of out of state license plates for the second and each subsequent out of state title from \$10 to \$25. The initial out of state title would remain \$10. For each increased title fee, Twelve dollars and fifty cents is retained by the county, six dollars is distributed to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund, four dollars and fifty cents are credited to the state's General Fund, and one dollar is dedicated for programs related to persons suffering from a brain injury.

The bill additionally creates a method for a voluntary two dollars for programs for persons suffering from brain injuries at the time of vehicle registration.
