LB 964 provides that no governing board of a county shall enter into a lease for oil and gas exploration and development in a county road right-of-way.

The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission estimates that potentially two additional public hearings per year beginning after July 1, 2010 would be necessary. The cost of the hearings is estimated to be \$750. The fees for applications would generate \$500 in revenue. Since the dollar figures are so low, it is likely that the Commission could absorb the expenditures within currently budgeted resources.
