LB 1081 as amended would establish the Teleworker Job Creation Act. The Department of Economic Development (DED) would be authorized to approve up to seven teleworker job training grant applications filed during FY10-11 with an expected total reimbursement amount of \$1,050,000. It is anticipated that approved grants could be paid from the existing Job Training Cash Fund appropriation.

DED states that the application review, project management and auditing will require increased administration and that up to \$20,000 may be expended for this purpose. Because the agency is able to pay for administrative costs from the Job Training Cash Fund, it is estimated that any increased staffing and operational costs would be paid from the existing fund appropriation.
