## Revision: 00 FISCAL NOTE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST ESTIMATE

\*Does not include any impact on political subdivisions. See narrative for political subdivision estimates.

This bill would change provisions relating to the offense of escape.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) estimates a minimal fiscal impact and their response follows:

LB275 adds language regarding the offense of escape. The bill expands the definition of official detention to include court ordered commitment to a regional center.

The penalties remain the same.

The impact to the Nebraska Department of Correctional Service (NDCS) is assumed to be minimal. The number of additional individuals potentially covered under this statute would be less than 260. (average daily census of the Nebraska Regional Centers in FY10 was 255), and the number convicted under this statute and sentenced to the NDCS is assumed to be minimal.
