LB 500 changes the penalty for having an object which obstructs or interferes with the view of a motor vehicle operator through the front windshield. Currently, a violation of this provision is a Class V misdemeanor. The bill makes it a traffic infraction subject to a fine of \$50 to \$150, depending upon the number of offenses. The fines are only imposed as a secondary action. A loss of one point on an individual's driver's license is also assessed for a violation.

The Department of Motor Vehicles will not have a fiscal impact pursuant to the bill to change the point system. The number of convictions pursuant to current law is unknown. It is possible there will be fewer convictions because persons can only be cited for an infraction as a secondary action.

Currently, the penalty for a Class V misdemeanor is a fine of up to \$100. It is assumed any change in revenue from fines will be minimal pursuant to the bill. Fine revenue accrues to the county where the violation occurs to be used for the public schools.
