According to the Personnel Almanac, the only state agency within the State Personnel System with more than 5,000 employees is the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). The fiscal impact cannot be determined since it is not known how many additional positions the head of DHHS will opt to exempt. It is also not known that if the head of DHHS opts to exempt additional positions whether the compensation will differ from that of the State Personnel System.
