LB 683 would establish the Storm Water Management Commission. The commission, consisting of three members of the Legislature, the directors of the Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Economic Development, and representatives from five other groups would serve without compensation or reimbursement. The commission would be directed to study various issues related to storm water management and submit a report with recommendations for proposed legislation to the Legislature and Governor on or before November 1, 2011. The act would also terminate on November 1, 2011.

Because LB 683 does not specify an agency that the commission would be housed in and what agency would provide staffing support, it is estimated that staff from the Legislative Council, the Department of Environmental Quality and the Department of Economic Development could be assigned to provide information, conduct research, develop legislation and compile report findings and recommendations. The amount of time spent by staff providing support would depend upon commission decisions.
