LB 95 creates the Employee Credit Privacy Act.

The bill would provide that it is the policy of the state of Nebraska that a person should not be discriminated against in obtaining or retaining employment because of their credit history or credit report unless that information relates to a bona fide occupational requirement.

The bill provides definitions including who is and who isn't an employer; restrictions on an employer regarding employment and the use of credit histories or credit reports; exceptions to the restrictions against using a credit history or credit report; prohibits discrimination against an employee because that employee has filed a complaint related to the Act; prohibits an employer from requiring a waiver of the Act from an employee or applicant; provides for a civil action in the appropriate district court; and allows an employer to conduct a background investigation that does not include a credit history.

There is no fiscal impact to the state as a result of LB 95.
