Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1062 requires the impounding of vehicles that are involved in an accident if the driver cannot produce an operator's license or proof of financial responsibility or insurance, and if the officer is not able to determine that such exists. In these cases, the Nebraska State Patrol will arrange for the vehicle to be towed and will forward a certified letter to the registered owner notifying the owner of the impounding of their vehicle. The Nebraska State Patrol has provided a range of Expenditures related to these activities for FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16 based on the assumption that a given percentage of accidents involve drivers who are not able to produce the required documents previously mentioned. The above estimates assume a range of 10%-15% for FY 2014-15 and a range of 10%-15% for FY 2015-16 (NE Office of Highway Safety statistics). These percentages and the base of 42,045 statewide accidents (Nebraska Department of Roads 2012 statistics) were utilized in calculating the estimated number of vehicles that would be impounded and range in number from 4.205 at 10% to 6,307 at 15%. Expenditures include the cost of mailing a certified letter to the owner at \$6.11 per letter per vehicle impounded (for the 10% and 15% scenarios this would equate to \$25,693, and \$38,536, respectively). Also included is the estimate that 10% of the towing costs and storage costs will not be recovered by the State Patrol. These costs will be incurred if a vehicle is abandoned and not claimed by its owner, and if the towing company does not wish to assume ownership of the damaged vehicle in lieu of payment. The cost of towing was assumed to be \$150 per vehicle, and storage costs were assumed to be \$15 per day for a period of 15 days per vehicle. It is estimated that the towing and storage costs that would not be recouped by the State Patrol would be in the range of \$157,687 to \$236,512 for the 10% and 15% scenarios described above.
