Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 580 would adopt the Redistricting Act. The bill proposes process and procedures for conducting the decennial redistricting. This includes creation of the Independent Redistricting Advisory Commission for the purpose of assisting the Legislature in the process of redistricting in 2021.

The bill would have no fiscal impact from what otherwise would occur in a redistricting process except for reimbursement of actual expenses of the advisory commission. Assuming a nine member commission (Section 19 references both a six member commission but nine appointees) and that the commission meets 8 times, expenses are estimated at approximately \$9,200. Note that these expenses would not occur until the next redistricting process in 2021.
