LB593 appropriates \$250,000 General Funds to the Board of Regents for the University of Nebraska Medical Center to study current health data systems available to the State and make recommendations about health data systems that are currently unavailable that would be beneficial to the State.

The Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of Insurance are to cooperate with the study.

The Department of Health and Human Services indicates the need for two .5 FTE's for 6 months at a cost of \$89,397 (\$69,557 GF; \$19,840 FF). The two half-time positions for 6 months appears reasonable. Operating costs appear high.

The Department of Insurance indicates no fiscal impact.

Explanation of Estimate:

To appropriate \$250,000 to the University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC) to study current health data systems available to the State of Nebraska and make recommendations about health data systems that are currently unavailable that would be beneficial to the state for purposes of increasing efficiency and effectiveness of public health care dollars spent in the state. Findings shall be reported electronically to the Nebraska Legislature no later than December 1, 2015.

The Division of Public Health would need to hire a full time Data Coordinator for 6 months (based on the timeline given to complete the study) if it is necessary to investigate and collect information on the current data sets/systems for assessment by UNMC at a cost of \$49,718 GF in SFY16.

The Division of Medicaid and Long-Term Care would require a Statistical Analyst II for 6 months to cooperate and connect with UNMC as the study is completed at a cost of \$39,679 total funds (\$19,839 GF, \$19,840 FF) for 6 months in SFY16.
