Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 821 creates the Workplace Privacy Act.

The bill would prohibit an employer from requiring an employee or applicant to disclose a user name, password, or related account information in order to gain access to the employee's or applicant's social networking site profile or account. It would also prohibit an employer from requiring an employee or applicant from logging on to such a site in the employer's presence so as to provide the employer access to the site.

The bill would also prohibit an employer from requiring an employee to waive their rights under the Act; prohibit retaliation by the employer or discrimination by the employer because the employee refused to disclose information covered by the Act or files a complaint under the Act; prohibits an employee from downloading proprietary or financial information of the employer's; enumerates instances where the employer's rights are not limited by the Act; and provides definitions.

The Act also provides that an aggrieved party may institute a civil action in district court and receive may receive injunctive relief, damages, and reasonable attorney's fees and costs.

The Department of Labor indicates no fiscal impact to the state or cost to the department to implement LB 821.

We agree with the department's estimate of fiscal impact and cost.
