Additionally, the bill requires that the State Patrol act as a repository for annual reports received from local law enforcement agencies regarding such denials and notifications. Lastly, it requires that the State Patrol publish a written report annually that provides detailed information regarding the denials, including statistics on the number of notifications, number of investigations opened, concluded, referrals for prosecution, and number of charges, as well as the reasons for the denials. The State Patrol currently does not receive notification of such denials. The ability to gather this data and the method by which this could be accomplished is currently unknown. The Patrol estimates that at a minimum, in order to obtain the above noted information, an IT application would need to be developed to gather this data. The Patrol estimates that this will involve development costs of approximately \$30,000. The Patrol also estimates that an additional Criminal Records Technician would need to be hired in order to gather, process, compile, and provide the information requested.
