This bill allows a person with one of more convictions for the possession our use of a controlled substance or a person with one or two felony convictions involving the sale or distribution of a controlled substance to be eligible for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) if certain conditions are met.

SNAP benefits are paid 100\% by the federal government. Administrative costs are matched at 50\% General and federal. The Department of Health and Human Services estimates this would increase the workload by approximately 187 cases. Based on current workload ratios, a half-time social service worker is needed. The cost would be $\$ 33,074$ ( $\$ 16,537$ GF and FF) in FY 17 and $\$ 38,096$ ( $\$ 19,048$ GF and FF) in FY 18. The department's fiscal note indicates that current staff can absorb the additional case work.

## Explanation of Estimate:

Between calendar years 2015 and 2016, and average of 649 individuals annually were closed or denied Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits due to being a convicted drug felon. This amount is increased by 15 percent $(746)$ to account for those who did not apply due to their conviction. It is assumed that 75 percent of these individuals would be added to a household already receiving benefits, so approximately 187 new cases would be opened, which can be absorbed by current staff.

SNAP benefits are 100\% federally funded.
