Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 442 creates the Medical Assistance Managed Care Organization Oversight Committee. This committee consists of seven members of the Legislature and is tasked to gather information and analysis related to the delivery of services under the medical assistance program and the Children's Health Insurance Program in Nebraska under the integrated managed care organization contract. The oversight committee would be operative until December 31, 2020.

Meetings for this oversight committee would be considered part of the regular legislative interim duties senators and part of the existing Legislative Council budget. Staffing for the oversight committee would come from existing legislative staff.

There would be additional costs if consultants are hired as authorized in Section 2 subsection 2. This is very possible in light of the listing of areas for examination in Section 2 subsection 4 including the issues of quality of care for and health outcomes of individuals receiving services and Integration and coordination of health care procedures. At this point it's difficult to arrive at a cost estimate as that would be determined by the extent the oversight committee chooses to utilize consultants and the work they would request be done. It could very well be in the range of \$25,000 to \$50,000 per year but an actual amount cannot be determined at this time.
