Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 346 eliminates the requirement for an individual to obtain a motor vehicle, motorcycle, or trailer salesperson license from the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board. The initial and renewal annual license fee is \$20. Licenses are currently issued on a calendar year basis and expire on December 31st of each year.

<u>Revenue</u>: The bill will reduce cash fund revenue of the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board by about \$161,580 of cash funds on an annual basis. This is the actual amount of revenue received from salesperson licenses in FY2015-16.

Expenditures: The Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board will experience a workload decrease in terms of issuing over 8,000 salesperson licenses each year. It is assumed the workload decrease will not be sufficient to eliminate existing staff, however, there should be some savings in printing and mailing costs related to the issuance of licenses. The estimated decrease in expenditures is \$7,600 on an annual basis.
