Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 109 authorizes the State Department of Education (NDE) to issue a temporary certificate or permit to teach to a military spouse who meets certain requirements specified in the bill pending issuance of a permanent certificate or permit. The temporary certificate or permit is valid for six months.

The bill may have a minimal fiscal impact in terms of increased revenue from teacher certificate fees. According to NDE, military spouses eligible for a temporary certificate will pay a fee for the temporary certificate. The fee is \$55 for a public school teacher and \$40 for a permit to teach in a non-public school. Forty-two dollars of the certificate fee for public school teachers and the entire fee (\$40) for non-public school teachers is deposited in the Certification Fund. Thirteen dollars of the certificate fee for a public school teachers and the entire fee (stop) for non-public school teachers is deposited in the Certification Fund. Thirteen dollars of the certificate fee for a public school teacher a public school teacher is placed in the Professional Practices Commission Fund. Upon meeting the requirements for a permanent certificate, military spouses will be required to pay a fee for the permanent certificate or permit.

It is assumed there will be a minimal number of military spouses who will be issued a temporary certificate or permit to teach pursuant to the bill, so the increase in cash fund revenue is not projected to be significant. It is also assumed that NDE can handle any expenses related to revising a rule with its existing budgetary resources.
