The Department of Health and Human Services would need a community health educator to develop reporting and follow-up protocols, lab results reporting, reporting letter, parental and health care professional educational materials. The cost would be \$53,955 GF in FY 2018 and \$65,941 GF in FY 2019.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 401 would add three conditions to the mandatory newborn screening prescribed in 71-519.

The Department would engage in planning, development, and implementation of screening for the three diseases. Staff time will be required to develop reporting and follow-up protocols, lab result reporting language, result reporting letters, parent information fact sheets, education for hospitals and health care professionals, and update the lab data system.

The Department would require 1.00 FTE Community Health Educator (Prog. 179). The contracting laboratory bills direct testing costs to hospitals, with an expected increase of \$23.75 per birth as a result of the addition of screenings in LB 401. These costs are not borne by the Department.
