Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB721 relates to 1st class city fighters. A firefighter or surviving spouse receiving a pension benefit or a surviving spouse of a firefighter receiving any benefit due to a duty-related death and any eligible dependents shall:

- Be entitled to participate in group health insurance or other coverage offered by the city or other plan sponsor.
- Have the coverage, premiums, and other amounts charged on the same terms as if the firefighter remained actively employed.
- Eligibility to participate shall end on the last day of the month in which the firefighter or surviving spouse is eligible for coverage under medicare.
- Dependent eligibility ends pursuant to the terms of the insurance or other coverage or applicable law.

LB721 has the potential to increase insurance costs due to the change in the make-up of the insurance risk pool.
