LB 1155 changes qualifications for persons applying for teaching certificates relating to employment experience in other states. The bill provides that applicants do not need to have held a teaching certificate issued by another state if certain criteria are met.

The changes will enable some applicants to obtain teacher certificates that would otherwise not obtain them under current law. It is assumed the number of persons affected by the bill will be small, so there will be a minimal increase in revenue from fees for teacher certificates. Any increase in revenue will be deposited in the Certification Fund and the Professional Practices Fund.

The bill will also have a minimal fiscal impact for the State Department of Education to revise a rule. It is assumed any increased expenditures can be handled with existing resources of the department.
