This bill will provide for jurisdiction over custody proceedings of juveniles as prescribed.

The Nebraska Supreme Court (Court) estimates no fiscal impact.

In the 2007 Session, the Court estimated a cost of \$21,530 per year. The Court noted that the bill will increase the workload of juvenile court judges, and they will not be able to absorb this kind of a workload shift. Therefore, they would have to use retired judges to cover this additional workload.

The Court received an additional juvenile court judge last session (LB 377). Therefore, the Court feels that it will be able to absorb the additional workload resulting from this bill.
