LB 1087 proposes to appropriate \$15,000,000 in federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) funds to the Nebraska's Community Colleges to be used as Aid for dual enrollment. Dual enrollment is an aid program whereby high school students can receive both high school and college credit for successful completion of certain designated courses during their junior or senior year of high school. The Aid covers the tuition cost for designated courses.

The bill appropriates the total \$15,000,000 for FY2022-23, but includes intent to be expended by the community colleges as follows:

FY2022-23 - \$5,000,000 FY2023-24 - \$5,000,000 FY2024-25 - \$5,000,000

The funds appropriated in this bill are to be distributed to community college areas in direct proportion to the full-time-equivalent enrollment in dual credit courses delivered by the respective community college areas, based on dual enrollment credit hour data reported to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education, and by the respective community college areas for the year in which those enrollments occurred. As such, the distribution varies among the community college areas and by year, so that no more than \$5,000,000 is to be spent in total in each of the next three fiscal years.
