Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1256 amends several sections to change provisions relating to public libraries & require an election of the library board members of metropolitan cities.

Each metropolitan city that establishes & maintains a public library & reading room will hold a non-partisan election of its library board members. One board member will be elected from the city council district & two members will be at-large and must be registered voters who reside in the metropolitan city. Members will serve four year terms & can be reelected.

The board will appoint a finance committee, a facilities committee, & other committees as needed from its members. The board will publish & hold monthly meetings that are open to the public.

The board can appoint a director to oversee the facilities & any appointed librarians, & assistants. The board will also decide the director's salary.

The library board will submit their annual report to their city council on or before December 15 each year.

EXPENDITURES:

The city of Omaha is currently the only metropolitan city in the state. There will be expenses for holding the election of the board members and other possible expenses but those expenses cannot be determined at this time as Omaha did not respond to our request.

The Nebraska Library Commission estimates no fiscal impact to the state.
