LB78 relates to the Political Subdivisions Tort Claims Act and changes the amounts recoverable under the Act. Currently the Political Subdivision Tort Claims Act limits the amount recoverable to \$1 million per person and \$5 million per occurrence. LB78 increases those limits to \$3 million per person and \$12 million per occurrence.

The City of Lincoln estimates the cost of annual insurance and self-insurance could increase \$2,000,000 to \$6,000,000.

The City of Omaha estimates the adoption of LB78 to require an additional \$2.5 million per year.

There is no basis to disagree with the estimates provided.
