LB1198 appropriates \$2,500,000 of federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) for FY2022-23 & declares an emergency.

The aid will be awarded through grants to nonprofit organizations holding a 501(c)(3) certificate to provide programming for mentorship, career exploration, & job readiness or postsecondary education at no cost to students who qualify for the federal free-lunch program.

EXPENDITURES:

NDE estimates the need for an additional FTE for oversee the grant distribution resulting in \$79,237 for salary/benefits & \$5,010 for operating expenses. The remaining \$2,415,753 would be distributed out through the provisions of this act.

COMMENTS: Agree with the agency that the bill would provide Federal Funds to the agency. Disagree that the agency would require a new position to manage the requirements of the bill.

The maximum funding available under the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund is \$1.04 billion, of which only \$520 million is currently available. Appropriation of these funds must be balanced in aggregate in order to avoid over obligation.

Technical Note: The language in section 1 of the bill does not provide the level of detail necessary to enact the appropriations intended.
