Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 887 adopts the Nebraska Nonprofit Security Grant Program Act. The Act creates a program to award grants to nonprofit organizations for security equipment and activities that are related to protecting a facility and persons utilizing such facility as outlined in the bill.

The Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) would administer the grant program. The effective date of the program is January 1, 2025. Funding for the grants would be awarded annually. The bill states intent to appropriate \$500,000 per year from the General Fund for the program until FY28-29.

NEMA has indicated that an additional Grants Administrator would be required to administer the program.

The FTE, benefits, operations, and travel costs total to \$88,317 in FY 2024-25. The reduction for these operating costs would leave \$411,683 in grant aid for FY 2024-25.

The FTE, benefits, operations, and travel costs total to \$90,232 in FY 2025-26. The reduction for these operating costs would leave \$409,768 in grant aid for FY 2025-26.

There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.
