Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1275 appropriates \$23,000,000 of General Funds to the Department of Administrative Services to establish interoperable communication between state agencies and volunteer departments and to provide training. The bill prohibits the office of the Chief Information Officer from charging any fee connected to the Statewide Radio System. The bill intends for these funds to be distributed by June 30,2026.

The OCIO estimates the cost for this system to be approximately \$51,862 per department with 435 departments yet to receive these radios. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1275 as introduced would appropriate \$23 million in General Funds in FY24-25 to establish interoperable communications between state agencies and volunteer departments by providing portable and mobile radios, including programming, installation, and training.

Section 2(b) prohibits the Department of Administrative Services - Office of the Chief Information Officer (DAS-OCIO) from charging any subscription, programming or training fee after a volunteer department receives a grant from the program.

The life expectancy of a radio is twenty years. In the table below the twenty-year State Radio System (SRS) costs are estimated to be \$1,252,274. This represents the ongoing costs for OCIO to maintain the radios on the system.

It is also assumed that after the life expectancy of a radio is met, any replacement radios and associated costs would be paid by the volunteer department that received the original grant.
