LB 5, as amended, would eliminate the current prohibition on trapping in the county road right-of-way, but would give counties the authority to prohibit such trapping on all or a portion of their right-of-way at their discretion.

There could potentially be a cash fund revenue increase from the issuance of a few additional fur harvest permits (\$16 for resident) to those individuals who want to trap in the county road right-of-way, and who have not purchased a permit due to the current prohibition. This permit revenue would be deposited into the Game and Parks Commission's Game Cash Fund. Any revenue increase will be minimal.
