Medical providers are prohibited from charging individuals who are applying for Medicaid and publicly-funded disability benefits for medical records. This bill repeals that provision.

Providers are allowed to charge state and federal agencies for medical records for individuals applying for benefits. The Department of Health and Human Services currently pays for copies of medical records. There is no fiscal impact.
