LB 415 changes requirements for a person to obtain a provisional operator's permit. A person applying for provisional permit must have a learner's permit for at least six months and must not have accumulated three or more points in the six month period prior to application for the permit. Applicants using a certificate to verify driving experience must also have driven at least ten hours between sunset and sunrise. The bill expands the length a time for which a school permit is valid by three months, to age sixteen and three months. LB 415 restricts the number of passengers allowed in a vehicle operated by a person with a provisional permit during the first six months of holding the permit. The bill also provides that holders of provisional operator's permits, learner's permits and school permits may not use any type of interactive wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle. The operative date of the bill is January 1, 2008.

The changes in the bill require the Department of Motor Vehicles to reprogram the conditions that must be met for the issuance of provisional and school permits. The estimated one-time cost for modifying the mainframe computer system is \$12,000. The back of the permits will also need to be changed to show restrictions which will cost the vendor an estimated \$33,000 for reprogramming in 2007-08.
