LB 217 changes provisions related to electrical entities placing a wire across a railroad right-of-way. Under the bill's provisions, the electrical entity shall pay the railroad company a one-time standard crossing fee of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250) for each applicable crossing. In addition, the electrical company shall reimburse the railroad company for any actual flagging expenses associated with the placement of the wire.
