LB 483 would have no fiscal impact to the Department of Natural Resources.

LB 483 would require natural resources districts (NRDs) affected by a Department of Natural Resources decision that a river basin, subbasin or reach is fully appropriated to adopt rules and regulations for prioritizing the granting of water well permits if a status change occurs. A status change would be defined as an expiration of a stay or a revision in the Department's preliminary determination. There would be administrative expenses for NRDs to develop rules and regulations in accordance with LB 483, but it is estimated that the duties could be carried out using the existing budgetary resources.
