LB 597 provides an additional option for school districts in a learning community which collaborate on focus programs, focus schools or magnet schools. The bill allows districts to establish an interlocal agreement specifying how the legal, financial and academic responsibilities for such program or school are to be shared. Current law provides for only one member school district to be designated as the primary school district.

The bill has no fiscal impact for the state. It has an unknown fiscal impact for school districts which may opt to collaborate on focus programs or focus or magnet schools through negotiated interlocal agreements.
