LB 602 changes the number of board members for educational service units (ESU's) beginning in January, 2009. Currently, the board for all ESU's, except ESU #18 and ESU #19, is composed of one board member from each county and four members at large. The bill changes the membership to twelve members, one member from each of twelve newly established election districts. The bill may have a minimal fiscal impact for ESU's in terms of increased or decreased reimbursement expenses for board members depending upon changes in the number of members on boards.
