Current statutory provisions require utilities to notify subscribers identified as welfare recipients of discontinuation of services due to nonpayment or past-due accounts. Such notices shall be by certified mail and notice of such proposed termination shall be given to the Department of Health and Human Services.

LB 734 removed that requirement. As a result, such individuals would be treated in a manner like non-welfare subscribers. Discontinuation notices would be either by written notice by mail or in person.
