This bill would change admission provisions relating to law enforcement training.

The Crime Commission states that the fiscal impact is unknown. The bill changes the criteria to apply for training at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center (Training Center) in Grand Island from citizen to "legal permanent resident who is actively seeking United States citizenship".

The Crime Commission expects the background checks on legal permanent residents will probably be more expensive to conduct, which will add to the operational costs of the Training Center.
