LB 632 would specify that if a livestock premises registration system is developed by the Department of Agriculture, that the system be voluntary. The department would also be directed to develop a process to allow withdrawal of registration that would remove premises identifiers from local, regional, state and federal databases, as coordinated in cooperation with law enforcement agencies. Individuals requesting a withdrawal would be served with an affidavit of removal from the registration system.

Because the Department of Agriculture does not currently operate a premises registration system, the provisions of LB 632 would have no fiscal impact to the agency. A withdrawal process would be factored into development costs if a registration system is created in the future.
