The State Treasurer estimates no fiscal impact.

The Supreme Court states the following:

LB 1026 pertains to the transfer of cases between district courts. Section 1(3), states that the court transferring the case will determine how filing fees for a new civil action will be paid by the transferring party. There is the potential for increased revenue, dependent on what each court determines, but any increase should not be significant. This is based on preliminary survey of the number of cases that are transferred which showed that probably less than 100 cases per year would be subject to these new procedures.
