LB 883 amends the Nebraska Liquor Control Act, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 53-123.11 and 53-164.01 dealing with the farm winery license.

The bill would allow the offsite storage of products produced at the winery in a designated, secure storage facility. The licensee would be required to notify the Liquor Control Commission of the location of the facility and maintain, at both the farm winery and the storage facility, a separate perpetual inventory of the product stored. Consumption of alcoholic liquor at the storage facility would be prohibited.

The bill would also allow for annual reporting of the total amount of wine packaged or bottled by the producer during the preceding year. Current statute provides for monthly reporting.

The fiscal impact of LB 883 is estimated to be minimal.
