LB 945 prohibits the use of a handheld wireless communication device to read, manually type or send a written communication while operating a motor vehicle which is in motion. Persons violating such provision are guilty of a traffic infraction and are assessed three points on their motor vehicle operator's license. The bill also establishes a fine of \$200 for a first offense, \$300 for a second offense and \$500 for a third and subsequent offense.

The bill has no fiscal impact for the Department of Motor Vehicles. It is unknown how many persons will be guilty of traffic violations pursuant to the bill. Any fines received pursuant to convictions will accrue to the county where the violation occurs to be used for the support of public schools.
