**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 115 (Pahls) would amend section 44-514 to provide that sections 44-514 to 44-521 (cancellation and nonrenewal of personal automobile liability policies) shall not apply to, among other things, any policy “subject to section 44-523” (cancellation of commercial automobile liability insurance policies) rather than shall not apply to any policy “insuring more than four automobiles”. This would repeal provisions which have been interpreted as imposing a limit of four automobiles which may be written on one policy.
