Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 404 would raise the salaries of the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission's commissioners.

The current salary of \$12,500 has not been adjusted for more than 30 years. The commissioners are appointed by the Governor for six-year terms and must receive legislative approval. The commission meets at least once a month, usually for two-day meetings, and the commissioners are reimbursed for expenses.

Details

Section 1 amends §53-112, relating to Liquor Control Commission salaries, by changing the amount that the commissioners are not to exceed annually from \$12,500 to \$25,000.

Section 2 repeals the original section.

Explanation of amendments, if any:

The committee amendment changes the "\$25,000" amount to "\$16,000".
