LB 143

Section 1. (1) No law enforcement officer, prosecuting

- 2 officer, or other government official shall ask or require an
- 3 adult, youth, or child victim of a sex offense as defined under
- 4 federal, tribal, state, territorial, or local law to submit to a
- 5 polygraph examination or other truth-telling device as a condition
- 6 for proceeding with the investigation of such offense.
- 7 (2) The refusal of a victim to submit to an examination
- 8 as described in subsection (1) of this section shall not prevent
- 9 the investigation of the offense.
