- FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend section 60-6,304, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change a penalty provision with respect to vehicle loads; and to repeal the original section.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-6,304, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 60-6,304 (1) No vehicle shall be driven or moved on
- 4 any highway unless the vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to
- 5 prevent its contents from dropping, sifting, leaking, or otherwise
- 6 escaping from the vehicle.
- 7 (2) No person shall transport any sand, gravel, rock
- 8 less than two inches in diameter, or refuse in any vehicle on any
- 9 hard-surfaced state highway if such material protrudes above the
- 10 sides of that part of the vehicle in which it is being transported
- 11 unless such material is enclosed or completely covered with canvas
- 12 or similar covering.
- 13 (3) No person shall drive or move a motor vehicle,
- 14 trailer, or semitrailer upon any highway unless the cargo or
- 15 contents carried by the motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer
- 16 are properly distributed and adequately secured to prevent the
- 17 falling of cargo or contents from the vehicle. The tailgate, doors,
- 18 tarpaulins, and any other equipment used in the operation of the
- 19 motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer or in the distributing or
- 20 securing of the cargo or contents carried by the motor vehicle,
- 21 trailer, or semitrailer shall be secured to prevent cargo or
- 22 contents falling from the vehicle. The means of securement to the
- 23 motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer must be either tiedowns and
- 24 tiedown assemblies of adequate strength or sides, sideboards, or
- 25 stakes and a rear endgate, endboard, or stakes strong enough and

high enough to assure that cargo or contents will not fall from the

- 2 vehicle.
- 3 (4) Any person who violates any provision of subsection
- 4 $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ or $\frac{(3)}{(3)}$ of this section shall be guilty of a Class IV
- 5 misdemeanor.
