#### A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds for
the payment of the salaries and benefits of certain state
officers for FY2007-08 and FY2008-09; to define terms; to
provide an operative date; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION LANGUAGE.
- 2 There are hereby appropriated, for FY2007-08 and
- 3 FY2008-09, the amounts specified in this act, or so much as may
- 4 be necessary, for the salaries and benefits of officers of the
- 5 Nebraska state government.
- 6 Sec. 2. DEFINITION OF APPROPRIATION PERIOD.
- 7 For purposes of this act, FY2007-08 means the period
- 8 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008, and FY2008-09
- 9 means the period beginning July 1, 2008, and ending June 30, 2009.
- 10 Sec. 3. NEBRASKA ACCOUNTING SYSTEM MANUAL DEFINITIONS.
- 11 The definitions contained in the Nebraska Accounting
- 12 System Manual, and any amendments thereto, on file with the Clerk
- 13 of the Legislature are hereby adopted by the Legislature as the
- 14 definitions for this act, except as provided in section 21 of this
- 15 act.
- 16 Sec. 4. DRAWING AND PAYING WARRANTS.
- 17 The Director of Administrative Services shall draw
- 18 warrants upon the proper fund in the state treasury for an amount
- 19 not to exceed the appropriations set forth in this act upon
- 20 presentation of proper documentation. The State Treasurer shall pay
- 21 the warrants out of the appropriate funds.
- 22 Workers' compensation premium assessments shall not be
- 23 paid from the programs listed in this act.

- 16 Sec. 21. LIMITATION ON SALARIES, WAGES, AND PER DIEMS.
- 17 (1) As used in this act:
- 18 (a) SALARY LIMIT means total expenditures for permanent
- 19 and temporary salaries and per diems; and
- 21 salaries and per diems means all remuneration paid to employees 22 treated as taxable compensation by the Internal Revenue Service

(b) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary

- 23 or subject to social security coverage, specifically including
- 24 payments accounted for as vacation, holidays, sick leave, military
- 25 leave, funeral leave, maternity leave, administrative leave,

1 compensatory time, deferred compensation, or any other similar

- 2 form, and amounts withheld pursuant to law, but excluding state
- 3 contributions for social security, retirement, and employee
- 4 insurance plans.
- 5 (2) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 6 salaries and per diems are limited to the amount provided by law
- 7 for constitutional officers.
- 8 (3) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and
- 9 temporary salaries and per diems for FY2007-08 shall be increased
- 10 by certified encumbrance amounts from FY2006-07 for permanent and
- 11 temporary salaries and per diems. The limitation on expenditures
- 12 for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for FY2008-09
- 13 shall be increased by certified encumbrance amounts from FY2007-08
- 14 for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems. Encumbered
- 15 amounts shall be calculated in accordance with section 81-138.01.
- 16 Sec. 22. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2007.
- 17 Sec. 23. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 18 when passed and approved according to law.
