FOR AN ACT relating to limited cooperative associations; to amend
section 21-2970, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2007; to
delete erroneous references to corporation that should be

Section 1. Section 21-2970, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2007, is amended to read:
- 3 21-2970 (1) A director shall discharge his or her duties
- 4 as a director, including his or her duties as a member of a
- 5 committee:
- 6 (a) In good faith;
- 7 (b) With the care an ordinarily prudent person in a like
- 8 position would exercise under similar circumstances; and
- 9 (c) In a manner he or she reasonably believes to be
- 10 in the best interests of the corporation. limited cooperative
- 11 association.
- 12 (2) In discharging his or her duties, a director
- 13 shall be entitled to rely on information, opinions, reports,
- 14 or statements, including financial statements and other financial
- 15 data, if prepared or presented by:
- 16 (a) One or more officers or employees of the corporation
- 17 limited cooperative association whom the director reasonably
- 18 believes to be reliable and competent in the matters presented;
- 19 (b) Legal counsel, public accountants, or other persons
- 20 as to matters the director reasonably believes are within the
- 21 person's professional or expert competence; or
- 22 (c) A committee of the board of directors of which he
- 23 or she is not a member, if the director reasonably believes the
- 24 committee merits confidence.
- 25 (3) A director shall not be considered to be acting in

- 4 (4) A director shall not be liable for any action taken
- 5 as a director or any failure to take any action if he or she
- 6 performed the duties of his or her office in compliance with this
- 7 section.
