1	Section 1. (1) An excise tax is imposed on all transfers
2	of money by wire originating in this state by a licensee under
3	the Nebraska Sale of Checks and Funds Transmission Act or an
4	incorporated telegraph company as described in section 86-601. The
5	rate of tax is one percent of the amount of the wire transfer.
6	The licensee or company shall collect the tax from the customer
7	at the time of the wire transfer. The licensee or company shall
8	provide a receipt to the customer which states the amount of the
9	wire transfer and the amount of the tax collected.
10	(2) The licensee or company shall remit the tax collected
11	to the Department of Revenue for credit to the Tax Equity and
12	Educational Opportunities Fund. Payment of the tax shall be
13	accompanied by a report setting forth the total dollar amount
14	of wire transfers during the reporting period. The report shall be
15	on a form prescribed by the department and shall include such other
16	information as the Tax Commissioner deems necessary. The tax and
17	report shall be remitted within thirty days after the end of each
18	<u>calendar quarter.</u>
19	(3) Any person violating this section shall be guilty of
20	<u>a Class III misdemeanor.</u>
21	(4) The Tax Commissioner shall adopt and promulgate rules
22	and regulations to carry out this section.
