A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to the Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool
Act; to amend section 44-4224, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, and sections 44-4221 and 44-4222, Revised Statutes
Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to change provisions relating
to eligibility for pool coverage and the duties of the
administering insurer; and to repeal the original sections.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 44-4221, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:
- 3 44-4221. (1) To be eligible to purchase health insurance
- 4 coverage from the pool, an individual shall:
- 5 (a) Be a resident of the state for a period of at least six
- 6 months and shall:
- 7 (i) Have received, within six months prior to application to
- 8 the pool, a rejection in writing, for reasons of health, from an
- 9 insurer;
- 10 (ii) Currently have, or have been offered within six months
- 11 prior to application to the pool, health insurance coverage by an
- insurer which includes a restrictive rider which limits insurance
- 13 coverage for a preexisting medical condition; or
- 14 (iii) Have been refused health insurance coverage comparable
- to the pool, or have been offered such coverage at a rate exceeding
- 16 the premium rate for pool coverage, within six months prior to
- 17 application to the pool; or
- 18 (iv) Not be eligible for coverage under a group health
- 19 <u>plan;</u>
- 20 (b) Be a resident of the state for any length of time and be
- 21 an individual:
- 22 (i) For whom, as of the date the individual seeks pool
- 23 coverage under this section, the aggregate of the periods of
- 24 creditable coverage is eighteen or more months and whose most recent
- 25 prior creditable coverage was under a group health plan, governmental
- 26 plan, or church plan;
- 27 (ii) Who is not eligible for coverage under a group health

1 plan, medicare, or medical assistance pursuant to the Medical

- 2 Assistance Act or section 43-522, or any successor program, and who
- 3 does not have any other health insurance coverage;
- 4 (iii) With respect to whom the most recent prior creditable
- 5 coverage was not terminated for factors relating to nonpayment of
- 6 premiums or fraud; and
- 7 (iv)(A) Who, if such individual was offered the option of
- 8 continuation coverage under COBRA or under a similar program, both
- 9 elected such continuation coverage and exhausted such continuation
- 10 coverage, or (B) who had been offered the option of continuation
- 11 coverage under COBRA or under a similar program at a premium rate
- 12 higher than that available from the pool; or
- 13 (c) Be a resident of the state for any length of time and be
- 14 a qualified trade adjustment assistance eligible individual.
- 15 (2) The board may adopt and promulgate a list of medical or
- 16 health conditions for which an individual would be eligible for pool
- 17 coverage without applying for health insurance coverage pursuant to
- 18 subdivision (1)(a) of this section. Individuals who can demonstrate
- 19 the existence or history of any medical or health conditions on the
- 20 list adopted and promulgated by the board shall be eligible to apply
- 21 directly to the pool for health insurance coverage.
- Sec. 2. Section 44-4222, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 23 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:
- 24 44-4222. (1) An individual shall not be eligible for initial
- or continued pool coverage if:
- 26 (a) He or she is eligible for medicare benefits by reason of
- 27 age or medical assistance established pursuant to the Medical

- 1 Assistance Act;
- 2 (b) He or she is a resident or inmate of a correctional
- 3 facility, except that this subdivision shall not apply if such
- 4 individual is eligible for pool coverage under subdivision (1)(b) of
- 5 section 44-4221;
- 6 (c) He or she has terminated pool coverage unless twelve
- 7 months have elapsed since such termination, except that this
- 8 subdivision shall not apply if such individual has received and become
- 9 ineligible for medical assistance pursuant to the Medical Assistance
- 10 Act during the immediately preceding twelve months, if such individual
- is eligible for pool coverage under subdivision (1)(b) of section
- 12 44-4221, or if such individual is eligible for waiver of any waiting
- 13 period or preexisting condition exclusions pursuant to section
- 14 44-4228;
- 15 (d) The pool has paid out one million dollars in claims for
- 16 the individual; or
- 17 (e) He or she is no longer a resident of Nebraska; -
- 18 (f) The premium for his or her pool coverage is paid by any
- 19 person not related to him or her by blood, marriage, or adoption; or
- 20 (g) He or she fails to provide information or records
- 21 requested by the administrator in order to determine continuing
- 22 <u>eligibility for pool coverage.</u>
- 23 (2) Pool coverage shall terminate for any individual on the
- 24 date the individual becomes ineligible under subsection (1) of this
- 25 section.
- 26 Sec. 3. Section 44-4224, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- Nebraska, is amended to read:

1 44-4224. The administering insurer shall:

2 (1) Perform all eligibility verification functions relating

3 to the pool, including the collection of information as may be

- 4 <u>necessary to determine eligibility for pool coverage. State agencies</u>
- 5 <u>may release such information to the administering insurer</u>
- 6 (2) Establish a premium billing procedure for collection of
- 7 premiums from covered individuals on a periodic basis as determined by
- 8 the board;
- 9 (3) Perform all necessary functions to assure timely payment
- of benefits to covered individuals, including:
- 11 (a) Making available information relating to the proper
- 12 manner of submitting a claim for benefits to the pool and distributing
- forms upon which submission shall be made; and
- 14 (b) Evaluating the eligibility of each claim for payment by
- 15 the pool;
- 16 (4) Submit regular reports to the board regarding the
- 17 operation of the pool. The frequency, content, and form of the reports
- shall be determined by the board;
- 19 (5) Following the close of each calendar year, report such
- 20 income and expense items as directed by the board to the board and the
- 21 department on a form prescribed by the director; and
- 22 (6) Be paid as provided in the plan of operation for its
- 23 expenses incurred in the performance of its services to the pool.
