Section 1. Section 43-536, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 43-536 In determining the rate of reimbursement for
- 4 child care, the Department of Health and Human Services Finance
- 5 and Support shall conduct a market rate survey of the child
- 6 care providers in the state. The Department of Health and Human
- 7 Services shall adjust the reimbursement rate for child care every
- 8 odd-numbered year at a rate not less than the sixtieth percentile
- 9 and not to exceed the seventy-fifth percentile of the current
- 10 market rate survey, except that (1) nationally accredited child
- 11 care providers may be reimbursed at higher rates and (2) for the
- 12 two fiscal years beginning July 1, 2003, 2007, such rate may be
- 13 less than the sixtieth percentile but shall not be less than the
- 14 rate for the immediately preceding fiscal year or the fiftieth
- 15 percentile, whichever is greater.
- 16 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2007.
- 17 Sec. 3. Original section 43-536, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 18 of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 19 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 20 when passed and approved according to law.
